

Camping Rules and Payment Terms

Electric Camping Fee is \$150 (\$155 if paid online). Camping forms and payments are due April 20th. Your site will be open to the waiting list after **April 20th** if payment is not received.

You are responsible for cleaning up your camping area. Guests are expected to clean up after their pets. Trash cans are provided at various locations. Should you leave your campsite after fair with trash, you will lose your spot for next year!

- Only 30-amp electric service for camper use is guaranteed.
- No motorized utility vehicles or auxiliary vehicles are allowed for operation at the Butler County Fairgrounds. This includes but is not limited to golf carts, service cars, three/four wheelers, ATV's, etc.
- Please be considerate of all campers in the camping parking area. Please limit 2 vehicles per camper site. Do **NOT** park anyone in. You do not know when that person may leave in an emergency.
- Only 1 camper per site. No sharing of electrical outlets to other campers. No Sub-Leasing out your site.
- The ag society is not responsible for any damage to your camping unit for any reason, nor lost or stolen items.

Campers are able to park no earlier than Monday, July 13th and should be removed by Monday, July 20th unless other arrangements are made with a fairboard member.
